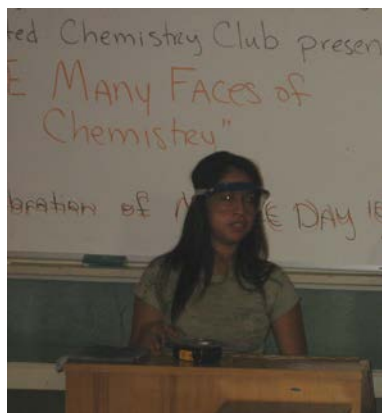

Congratulations to the Chemistry Club and the rest of the student participants for an excellent job on the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Student Demonstration Show!!!

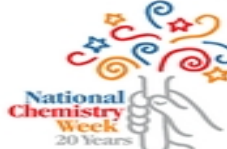
Fantastic job to all for presenting Mole Day at its best. ☺



Grigor and Bertha below demonstrate the science behind special effects. Where would Hollywood be without its chemists!



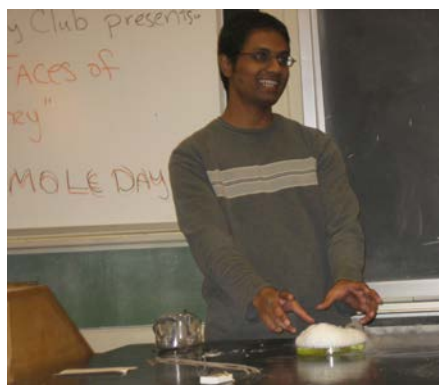

Daniela, our club president, starts the show off with words of encouragement.

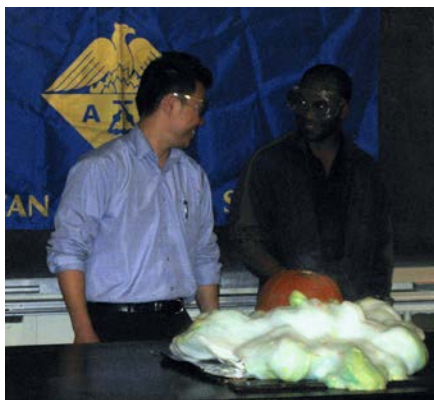


Serge prefers to ignite the world with his interest in the chemistry of pyrotechnics!!

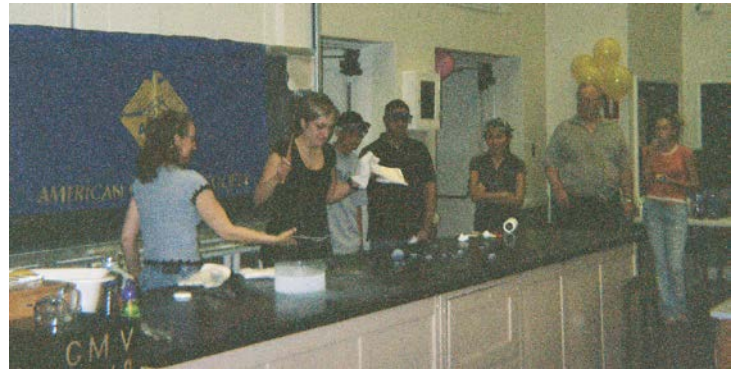
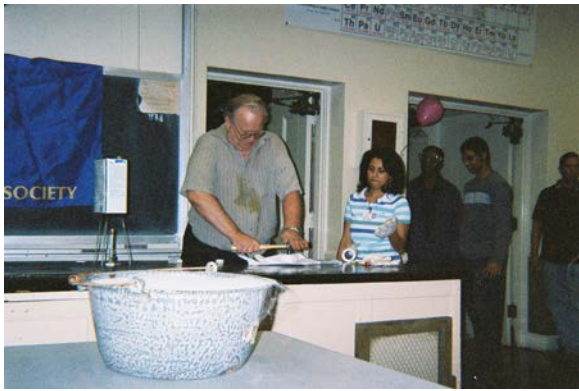


A popular attraction: Igniting bubbles filled with methane,  $\text{CH}_4$ .
